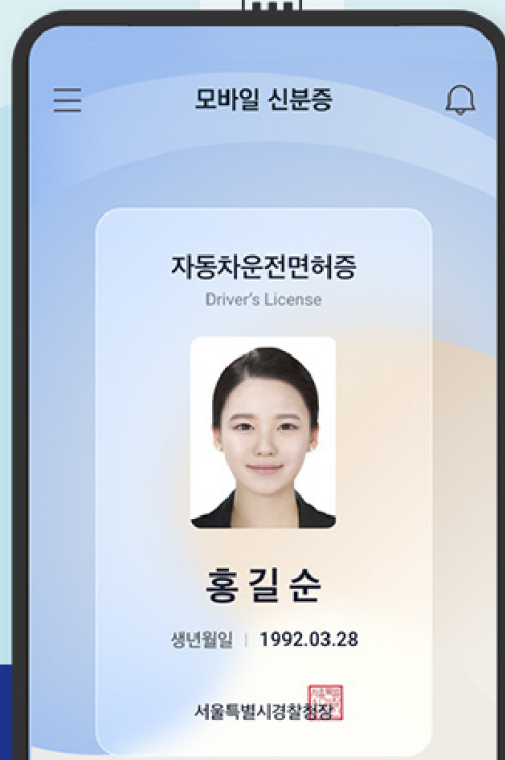

## Who can apply for a Mobile Driver's License?

---



**Anyone** with a valid driver's license or expecting to get one for the first time can apply.

\* If you are a foreign national, you must have a Residence Card and a Korean driver's license and be a Korean mobile phone service user.

---



## Do I have to return my existing driver's license if I get the Mobile Driver's License?

---



You **do not have to return your physical driver's license**. You can keep your existing card even after applying for a Mobile Driver's License.

\* You must keep a physical driver's license in either plastic or IC card.



## What should I do if I lose my smartphone?

---

**A**

As soon as you report a lost or stolen phone, your Mobile Driver's License **will automatically be locked and unavailable for use**. In case you find your phone, you can take a simple identity verification process to **unlock your Mobile Driver's License and start using it again**.

## Is it safe to have a Mobile Driver's License?

---



Using [blockchain technology](#), your Mobile Driver's License is safely encrypted and stored on your personal device. Furthermore, the app is secured with [anti-capture, anti-tamper solutions](#).

## What happens if my Mobile Driver's License is suspended or canceled?

---



Your Mobile Driver's License will be [suspended or canceled](#) and unavailable for use on your device. Once the suspension is lifted, the Mobile Driver's License [will automatically be updated](#). If your driver's license is canceled, you must reapply for a Mobile Driver's License at the time of reacquiring your driver's license.



## Do I have to apply for a Mobile Driver's License again if I change my smartphone?

# A

Yes, you must apply for it again if you change your smartphone. A Mobile Driver's License is **valid for three years**. Once it expires after three years, you must apply for it again.

If you have a driver's license IC card and a smartphone, you can easily apply for the Mobile Driver's License without visiting the office in person.

You can apply for a driver's license IC card online on the official KoROAD website on safe driving ([www.safedriving.or.kr](http://www.safedriving.or.kr)) or at one of the driver's license test centers.
